Over the coming months there will be noticeable changes around Bonville. Some of the changes have commenced including the clearing of vegetation on the eastern side of East Bonville Road. Shortly, excavation works will commence to realign East Bonville Road east of Pine Creek Way so that the old bridge is no longer used. The realignment will see East Bonville Road intersect with Pine Creek Way just to the left of where the bridge currently stands. Once this work is performed contractors will dismantle the bridge, the bridge has seen better days. The current East Bonville Road from the intersection next to the school through to the bridge will become a cul-de-sac. If you have seen the bus interchange in full swing from 3:45pm you would appreciate the improvement in safety for pedestrians and motorist once work is completed. Pedestrians and cyclist who require access to the eastern side of Pine Creek Way will use a footpath down to Pine Creek Way and cross the road which will be narrowed with sanctuary zones. At this stage it is unclear how the cul-de-sac will look. The school and bus companies have requested curb and guttering with a concrete footpath extending right around the perimeter. All of this will come down to available funds. It is expected the work will be completed by the beginning of the 2014 school year.
